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## Rep Weave Placemats – Step II

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### Dates/Hours:

Apr 14 and 15, Sat & Sun, 10am to 3pm  
Apr 28, Sat, 10am to 1pm

Rep Weave comes from the term ripsmatta, from the Swedish words rips (“rep”) and matta (“mat”). This plain weave structure is traditionally woven in 2 blocks, 2 colors, with a fine warp thread set densely so as to totally cover the weft which is alternating thick/thin threads. Designing is great fun as 4 blocks can be woven on 4 shafts and even a two block design can appear to look like more.

This class will focus on calculating warp length, winding a multi-colored warp, threading from a profile and hem finishing. 4 cotton placemats, approx 12” x 17” will be completed.

*Priority registration will be given to 2010-2012 Bloomsbury beginning weaving students until Feb 15, 2012. After that date, class will be open to all weavers.*

Half the cost of the class is a non-refundable deposit.

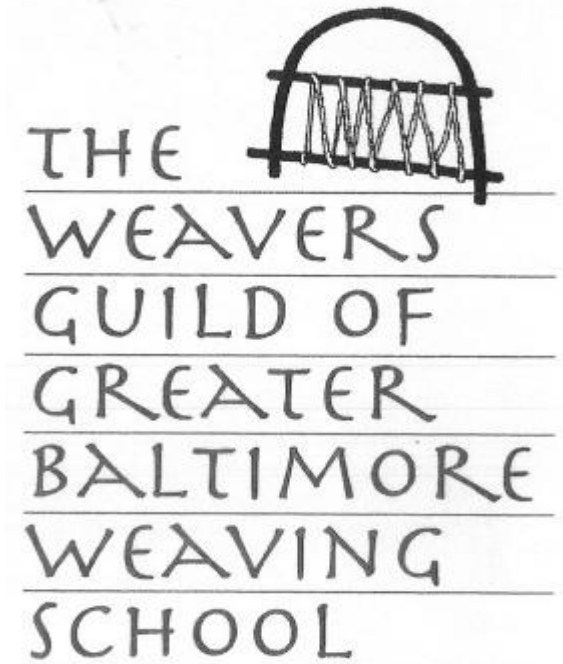
If a student cancels his/her registration two weeks or more before the class begins, one-half the cost of the class will be forfeited. Anything paid above that amount will be refunded in full.

Students should expect to spend two to five hours of homework per project.

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## Bronson Lace Towels – Step II

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### Dates/Hours:

Mar 3 & 10, Sat: 10:00am to 3:00pm

Mar 24, Sat: 10:00am to 1:00pm

Students will create a sampler after warping looms in a striped Bronson Lace pattern using solid and variegated cotton warp yarns. The sampler will show up to 16 variations from one threading, weaving with the same yarns for weft as used for the warp. Several fingertip towels will be woven using the sampler as a resource.

Students will learn about sett variations in one warp, how to create even selvages using fishing line and how to remove the sampler without wasting warp to re-tie.

***Note: Priority registration will be given to 2010-2012 Bloomsbury beginning weaving students until Jan 15, 2012. After that date class will be open to all students.***
